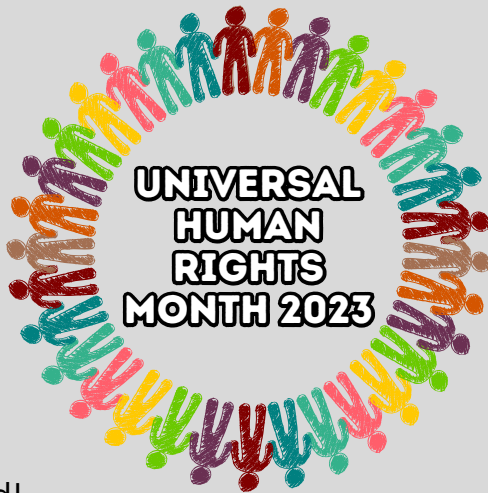


# NDPS VICTIM SERVICES - DECEMBER 2023
